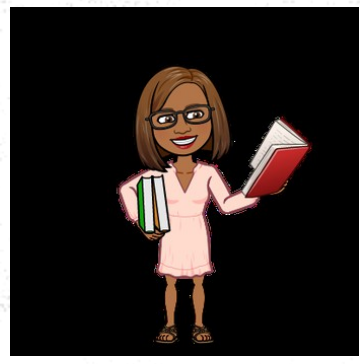
MS. TONJA DAVIS
